**Swindon - Kingsdown**

Minor changes to morning peak journeys.

**7 Swindon - Highworth**

Minor changes to the timetable to improve reliability.  
The Saturday daytime frequency will be increased to every 10 minutes between 0900hrs and 1720hrs

**8 Swindon - Freshbrook**

Minor changes to the timetable to improve reliability.  
The Saturday daytime frequency will be increased to every 10 minutes between 0900hrs and 1650hrs

**20 Marlborough - Bedwyn**

The Wiltshire Council tendered journeys at 1955hrs from Marlborough and 2015hrs from Bedwyn Station, operated by Stagecoach West, will be withdrawn.

**Swindon - Trowbridge**

Service unchanged.

**51 151 Swindon - Cirencester / Cirencester - Cheltenham**

Service unchanged.

**54 Swindon - Wootton Bassett**

This service will be withdrawn as a result of the diversion of Service 55 via Woodshaw Estate. There will be no service to Maple Drive and the New Road area will be provided for by Service 31, run by another bus operator. **55 Swindon - Chippenham**

A new timetable will be introduced to improve reliability and enable a regular 20 minute interval peak frequency from Swindon and Chippenham termini. The service will also be rerouted via Woodshaw Estate to provide an improved 20 minute interval frequency replacing the existing 30 minute one offered by Service 54.

**55A Swindon - Chippenham (evenings and Sundays)**

The service will no longer serve Maple Drive.

**65 Swindon - Faringdon**

Service unchanged.

**Swindon - Faringdon / Faringdon - Oxford**

Minor changes to the timetable at peak times to improve reliability.

**70 80 Swindon - Marlborough / Marlborough - Andover**

These services will become wholly operated by Stagecoach West except on weekday evenings. Service 70 will be provided commercially between Swindon and Marlborough during the main part of the day on Mondays to Saturdays. The evening service will be provided by another bus operator but the full range of Stagecoach tickets and passes will be valid on those journeys.

The Service 80 section of the route will still be provided as a direct connection at Marlborough, usually without a change of bus, but will only operate as far as Ludgershall or Tidworth and provide direct connections onto the Active 8 route to and from Andover, which is operated by Stagecoach South. Through tickets will be available.

**71 Swindon - Thorney Park**

Unchanged at present.

**72 Swindon - Wroughton**

A new timetable will be introduced to improve reliability, although the service frequency will be reduced to every 30 minutes during the off peak period Monday to Saturday. However, when considered with Service 49 and the new Service 73 below, there will still be four daytime departures per hour between Swindon and Wroughton.

The evening service will be withdrawn after Swindon Borough Council ends its funding after operation on Saturday 4th June 2011.

**72A Swindon - Marlborough**

The 2255hrs journey from Swindon to Marlborough via Wroughton on Monday to Saturday will no longer be operated by Stagecoach West, albeit Stagecoach tickets and passes will be valid on that journey. **73 Swindon - East Wichel**

This new service will operate between Swindon, East Wichel and Wroughton during Monday to Saturday daytimes. A special introductory promotional fare between Swindon and East Wichel will apply until 18th April 2011 to celebrate the first direct bus route between this developing estate, Old Town and the Town Centre.

**74 75 Swindon - Fairford**

Unchanged at present.

**Sunday services in the Swindon urban area**
