Abbotsford House



Abbotsford House is situated in the Scottish Borders along the banks of the River Tweed. It was once the home of 19th century poet and novelist Sir Walter Scott and today attracts thousands of visitors to the house and gardens each year.

This tour includes a visit to the house and gardens where you will see Sir Walter Scott's study, library, drawing room, armouries and dining room where he died in 1932. You can also walk round the chapel, the extensive gardens and follow the woodland walks in the grounds of the house.

The house holds an impressive collection of historic relics, weapons and armour and over 9000 rare books.
