- Black Watch Memorial commemorates the regiment who were tasked with looking over the Highlands in the 1700s. Benches nearby to have a seat and take in the beautiful views.
- Splash White Water Rafting offer rafting, canyoning, paddle boarding, paintballing and loads more!
- Visit Dewar's Aberfeldy Distillery where you can learn the story of the founder John Dewar, indulge in tasting from their single cask or go for a tour around the distillery.
