A list of things to see and do when visiting Dunfermline and the nearby area:

- Fife Leisure Park has so much to offer from food and drink to a round of mini golf or a film at the ODEON Cinema or a game of Bowling. More info [here](#).
- Take a trip on the 19 route and stop off at one of the many places available for food and drink along the way.
- Visit Lochore Meadows – At the heart of the park there is a beautiful loch that you can walk right the way around whilst taking in the nature and wildlife there or you could get the water with one of the Watersports activities on offer to take part in. There is also a beach and adventure playground that children can play in as well as brilliant spots for picnics or a barbecue to be had. More info [here](#).
- Get off at Dunfermline bus station and take the short walk into the beautiful Pittencrieff Park - go for a walk along the burn, visit the Peacock Rooms Café for a bite to eat, try to spot the peacocks around the park or in the peacock house or explore the botanical garden inside the greenhouse.
