Loch Leven, a fresh water loch located east of Kinross

A list of things to see and do whilst adventuring Loch Leven:

- Loch Leven National Nature Reserve allows you to take in the wonderful wildlife in the area and there are canoeing, kayaking and paddle boarding opportunities.
- Loch Leven Heritage Trail shows off the beautiful spots on the lochside. Perfect for people who love to walk or cycle.
- Loch Leven Larder offers a selection of cafes from the Larder café to the Greenhouse café. It is bike-friendly and has a play area for kids. They also have a gift shop.
- Head into Kinross and try the Loch Leven Brewery. Try locally brewed craft beer in their Tap Room and browse their shop to take some home.
- Kinross and Milnathort golf clubs offer two challenging but fair golf courses that golf lovers will relish.
- Head into Milnathort and take a stroll through the Memorial Park where you can see the war monument. Also, you can take in the well-maintained landscape and flowers.
