5, 5A, 5C
Milton Park & Ride

When are the timetable changes happening?

Our timetable tweaks will be starting from
Sunday 15th March

Why are you changing the 5, 5A and 5C, and what are the changes?

Change is never easy, and it isn't our intention to confuse you, but our 5, 5A and 5C services have been getting delayed due to the A14 road works so we're tweaking services to adjust to this. We want you to get where you're going as smoothly as we can.

5 – From Bar Hill Tesco:

Our morning 06:25 journey will now leave at 06:20 arriving at Cambridge city centre 5 minutes earlier at 06:49.

Our morning 07:55 journey will now leave at 8:00 arriving at Cambridge city centre 16 minutes later at 08:41.

All other AM peak journeys (between 06:55 and 09:00) will leave Tesco at the current timetable times, but will arrive 11 minutes later to Cambridge city centre.

These changes will occur Monday to Friday.

5 - From Fenstanton:

Our morning 06:00 journey will now arrive at Cambridge city centre 10 minutes later, at 07:35.

Our morning 06:56 journey will now leave at 06:50 and will arrive at Cambridge city centre 16 minutes later at 08:41.

These changes will occur Monday to Friday.

5 – From Cambridge City Centre:

Some of our morning journeys will leave a few minutes earlier:

07:50 now 07:45, 08:10 now 08:05, 08:30 now 08:26, 08:50 now 08:47.

All journeys starting from 14:50 until 18:10 will arrive at Bar Hill Tesco 10 minutes later.

These changes will occur Monday to Friday.

5A, 5C – From Bar Hill Tesco:

We've changed all our 5A and 5C services to leave Bar Hill Tesco at 5 past each hour.

Apart from our 14:47 journey (previously departing at 15:00) which departs at 14:47 in order to make sure we arrive to Swavesey Village College before the students leave.

These changes will occur Monday to Friday.

Why are you changing the Milton Park & Ride and what are the changes?

Our Milton Park & Ride service has been getting delayed due to central Cambridge congestion. We also want to provide a better service along Milton road, so we're tweaking services to adjust to this.

Our Milton Park & Ride service will now be every 12 minutes.

We will also be stopping at the Westbrook Centre and Union Lane on Milton Road.

After 18:30 the service will stop at any stop along the line of the route upon request.

We've simplified! All journeys will now follow the same route.

Every one of our journeys towards Cambridge city centre will stop at the entrance to the Science Park.

Busway Service Changes 15th March 2020

I've heard the Milton Park & Ride won't be stopping at the Grafton Centre anymore?

Yes, we're sad to say we're no longer able to run the Milton Park & Ride to the Grafton Centre.

Due to regular, heavy congestion between Cambridge city centre and the Grafton Centre, it makes our journeys a lot more unreliable. This change is to make sure we can maintain the level of service that you expect.

The service will start at Milton Park & Ride, through Milton Road ending at Cambridge city centre.

Alternatively, you can get the Newmarket Park and Ride bus from Cambridge city centre to the Grafton Centre.
