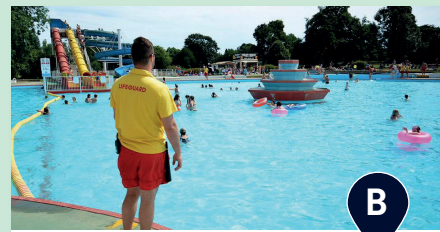


Alice Holt Forest

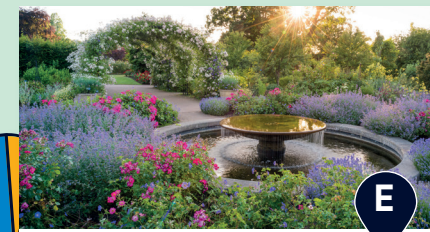


Victoria Place Shopping Centre

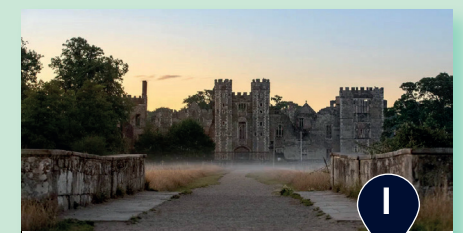


Guildford Museum

Cowdray Heritage Ruins
