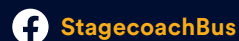

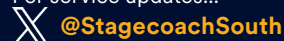

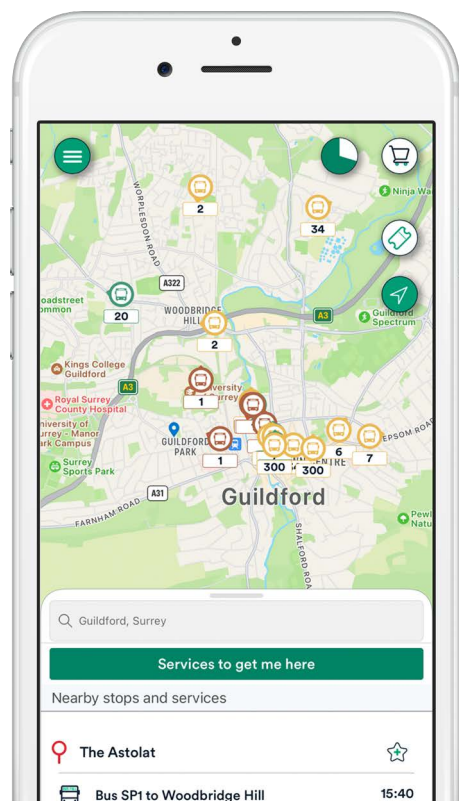
Guildford Castle

Your routes in Hants & Surrey

Guildford Park & Ride

Up to every 30 minutes into the town centre from our Artington & Merrow sites. Great for saving on parking.

Guildford Town Centre

Up to every 15 minutes into and across the town centre connecting you to The Friary shopping centre, G Live and Guildford Spectrum to name a few.

Gold 1 in Aldershot & Camberley

Every 12 minutes. Known as the 'home of the British Army', Aldershot is rich with military history. The Gold 1 connects you to Farnborough, known for its famous air show and great shopping facilities at The Meads. Camberley is home to many independent shops and Cafés.

Route 1 in Guildford & Manor Park

Up to every 15 minutes between Guildford, Surrey Sports Park, and the University of Surrey. A night bus (N1) also runs between 0000-0500 during university term time.

Route 2 in Guildford & Stoughton

Up to every 20 minutes connecting Stoughton to the town centre and the Friary.

Route 6 in Guildford & Merrow Park

Up to every 20 minutes. Stop off at Elgin Gardens for Guildford Spectrum, a multi-use complex filled with an ice rink, bowling, swimming and more.

Route 15 in Aldershot & Tices Meadow

Every 20 minutes. Stop off at Aldershot Lido in the warmer months for swimming, water flumes, diving platform as well as a toddler pool and sandpit.

Route 18 in Aldershot, Farnham, Bordon & Whitehill

Hourly. Not only can you get to Alice Holt Country Park on this route, but it also stops at Farnham's famous Birdworld, home to penguins, owls, parrots and more.

Route 34 & 35 in Guildford, Woking, Knaphill, Lightwater & Camberley

Every 30 minutes. Ideal services connecting you to the main shopping and entertainment hubs. The 34 is great for football fans, dropping you right outside Woking FC. Woking Leisure Centre is not far, with a range of flumes, rapids, and activities for everyone to enjoy. Both services stop outside Victoria Place Shopping Centre, complete with budget outlets, a theatre and cinema.

Route 70 in Guildford, Haslemere & Midhurst

Hourly. Ride into the South Downs stopping at Haslemere and Midhurst. Midhurst is home to Cowdray Ruins, one of England's most important Tudor Houses with many events across the year, and its own café.

Route 71 in Guildford & Haslemere

Hourly. Ride into the South Downs national park stopping at Haslemere, a great starting point for many walks. It's also home to Haslemere Education Museum, natural history & geology specimens.
