Route 700 in Portsmouth, Havant & Chichester

Up to every 20 minutes. Connecting Portsmouth to Chichester via scenic coastal landscapes and villages.

Stop in Emsworth and stroll along the Oyster Trail, the perfect spot for views across the Solent. Ride all the way to Portsmouth for a host of attractions and connections to the Isle of Wight.

Route 700 in Chichester, Bognor Regis & Littlehampton

Up to every 15 minutes between Chichester & Flansham Park. **Up to every 30 minutes between** Chichester & Littlehampton. Stop at the seaside town of Bognor Regis, home to Butlins.

Littlehampton offers the large seafront green, Harbour Park attractions & crazy golf to name a few.

Route 700 in Brighton, Worthing & Littlehampton

Up to every 12 minutes. There's so much to do in Brighton from the traditional fairground attractions on the Pier and beach, to vintage shopping in the Lanes. Not to mention the British Airways i360, taking you 450ft in the air.

Worthing has its pavilion theatre, promenade and is also a great place to start walking trails into the South Downs. Continue to Littlehampton and wind down with fish and chips down the river Arun, sand dunes or boating lake nearby.

Route 1 in Worthing & Midhurst

Every hour. With services taking you from the seaside to the South Downs. Stop off at the National Trust Cissbury Ring the highest hill fort in Sussex. Petworth House is also en route, it's a National Trust estate home to a 17th century mansion and 700-acre deer park.

Route 17 in Brighton & Horsham

Every hour. Connecting the busy city of Brighton with the historic market town of Horsham. Hop off at Leonardslee Gardens and explore the local heritage and sculpture park for a picturesque day out.

Route 600 in Chichester, Pagham & Bognor Regis

Up to every 30 minutes. Stop at Pagham with it's wonderful harbour walk, or why not unwind at Bognor beach with an ice cream in hand? Chichester is a fantastic stop with it's historic cathedral and pebbled high street.

Route 60 in Chichester & Midhurst

Up to every 30 minutes. Connecting you to the South Downs. Sit on the top deck for spectacular views across the national park. The route stops a short walk from the Weald & Downland Museum, you can also visit Cowdray Ruins in Midhurst itself. The ruins host many events across the year and has its own farm shop and cafe.

Route 51 in Chichester & Selsey

Up to every 20 minutes. Connecting the city centre to Selsey beach. Hop off at Selsey West Sands Holiday Park for a variety of activities and entertainment. You can enjoy beautiful landscapes, rich cultural heritage, and wetland wildlife all at RSPB Pagham Harbour.

Chichester City Centre

Buses up to every 15 minutes into and across the city, including the Cathedral, the arts venues and bustling high street with its many shops and cafés. Take a relaxing walk along the canal, or a fun filled night out at Chichester Gate Leisure Park.

Route 20 in Havant, Leigh Park, Cosham & Portsmouth

Up to every 30 minutes. Connect to Havant rail station and the leisure centre for gym, swim, and soft play for the little ones. Visit Fort Purbrook for a wide range of activities, for both adults and children alike.

Route 21 in Havant, Leigh Park, Anchorage Park, Copnor & Portsmouth

Up to every 10 minutes, going between Anchorage Park and Portsmouth. **Every 30 minutes,** going between Havant and Portsmouth. Ideal for getting into the heart of the city. Or visit Staunton Country Park with its 1,000 acres of landscaped parkland, a lake, follies, and ancient woodland to explore.

Route 23 in Leigh Park, Havant, Portsmouth & Southsea - now 24/7

Up to every 10 minutes. Connecting you to Havant bus station and the Hard Interchange at Portsmouth (for boat and rail connections). The Hard Interchange is also the best place to get off for Gunwharf Quays & Portsmouth Historic Dockyard. Southsea is home to Clarence Pier and South Parade with its rides, crazy golf and arcades.

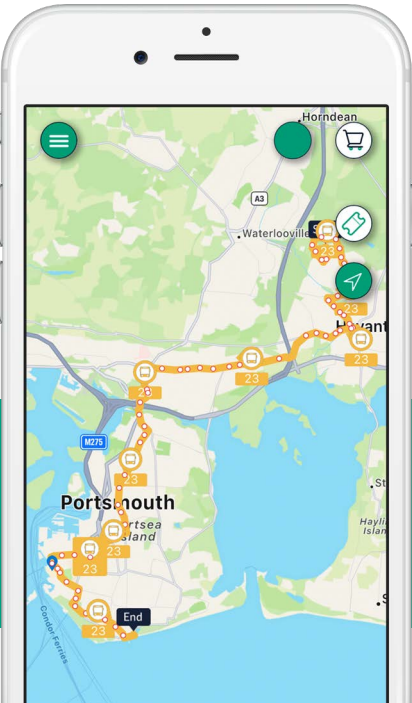
Route 37 in Havant & Petersfield
