All child tickets are available for:

- All children aged under 11.
- Child aged 11-16 with a valid regional ID card (e.g. Megatravel card).
- All young people aged 16-18 with a valid ID card (e.g. 16-18 Travel Pass).

Valid on all Stagecoach buses and Supertram in South Yorkshire and as far as Dronfield, Eckington, Killamarsh and Norwood.

Valid on all Stagecoach buses and Supertram in South and West Yorkshire, Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire and Gainsborough. Not valid on X62 or in the Glossop area. Dayrider Gold is not valid on Pronto, but megarider Gold is.

Group Tickets

5 for a Fiver £5 (frozen)

- This ticket has the same boundaries as the dayrider Silver ticket but is not valid on Supertram, X1, X6 or X10.
- Valid for 2-5 people to travel together at weekends and on Bank Holidays and now from 5pm on Friday evenings.

Tram Only Family Day £9

Tram Only Family megarider £33*

Why have tickets changed?

We know that when you are buying tickets there are lots of options to choose from – too many if we're honest. We have simplified our tickets to make them easier to understand for everyone.

My ticket doesn't exist anymore – which ticket do I need?

Visit our website [stagecoachbus.com](https://www.stagecoachbus.com) for a list of replacement tickets or if you are not sure If you are not sure, just get in touch and we will be happy to help.

How can I buy tickets?

You can buy tickets in the same way that you can now. On buses, using cash or your contactless payment card. On the Stagecoach Bus App Online at [Stagecoachbus.com](https://www.stagecoachbus.com)

Why is it cheaper online and on the app?

Stagecoach week tickets and most Travelmaster week ticket prices are frozen when bought off bus or tram in advance. When you have your ticket before you get on, it makes the journey faster for everyone.

Will I need to get a new smartcard?

No, your smartcard will still work, you will just need to load a different ticket on to it next time you buy one.

I have a monthly ticket, what happens to my direct debit?

If you haven't already, you will shortly receive an email from us about your monthly ticket.

After 2nd January, your old monthly ticket might not be available to buy any more. Any tickets you bought in December will still be valid to use until the expiry date, after that you will need to log in to your Stagecoach account and buy a new ticket.

I have bought tickets on the app and now I can't use them – what can I do?

You will get an email from our app team if you have pre-bought tickets for January that you won't be able use. If you haven't heard from us, just get in touch at Yorkshire.enquiries@stagecoachbus.com so we can help.

I buy ticket vouchers or scratchcards from my place of work, what happens now?

If you buy paper ticket vouchers or scratchcards from where you work you will still be able to do that, but will need to check with your business as there may be some changes, especially with tickets which are no longer available.

Why does my ticket cost more?

We have changed some of the tickets we offer to make travelling simpler, which means some tickets have gone up, some cover larger areas, some tickets are cheaper and some are frozen in price. If you buy online or on the app then your week and month tickets work out cheaper than on the bus or tram. Tram only tickets have changed to account for increasing costs over the last year.

What are the options?

Singles & Returns

We have reduced the number of single fares available to customers on buses. Some fares will be increased, some reduced and some frozen. Single fares on tram won’t change.

Local Tickets

In Sheffield the Citybus, Silver or Citywide tickets will be the best value for travelling in the City or tram only if you only want to travel on Supertram.

Stagecoach bus only and bus and tram tickets in Sheffield are replaced by the Silver ticket which allows you to travel much further afield including the Tram Train to Rotherham.

Travelling in Sheffield and surrounding areas

dayrider Silver & megarider Silver Tickets

- If you are travelling further than just the Sheffield area, you probably need a dayrider or megarider Silver ticket.
- Silver tickets also include Supertram and Tram Train in Rotherham.
- The megarider Silver zone is everywhere the current SY megarider Plus covers, and the megarider Plus zone in Chesterfield.

dayrider Gold & megarider Gold Tickets

- Gold tickets cover all of the Silver area, plus a bit extra. So Leeds, Nottingham, Matlock and Buxton are some of the areas that you will need a Gold ticket to travel in and around.
- The current Explorer day ticket will change its name to dayrider Gold.

Online discount

Pay less for your 7 day megarider ticket when you buy online or on the app.
