

## Position: Infrastructure Electrical Technician

- Install, maintain and repair all aspects of the Infrastructure power distribution, lighting and signalling systems
- Carry out planned maintenance on high power DC switching and protective devices
- Install new equipment as technology and projects require
- Diagnose and rectify faults on various control systems
- When carrying out day to day activities share all ideas for continual improvement.
- Implementation and adherence to HR policies and procedures
- Must have a can do attitude with a positive outlook.
- Must be able to demonstrate the ability to organise and prioritise
