- Communicate effectively and in a friendly manner with both customers and staff – this includes the use of the on-board Public Address system
- Remain cool, calm and responsible at all times
- Observe Rules, Regulations and Instructions relevant to the post of Tram Driver

The successful candidate will receive a salary of £26,391.18 pa on successful completion of the training period. Other benefits include free travel for you and your partner on all Stagecoach services, optional pension scheme and death in service benefit.

Candidates are assessed throughout the training period, if the required standard is not met your contract may be terminated.
