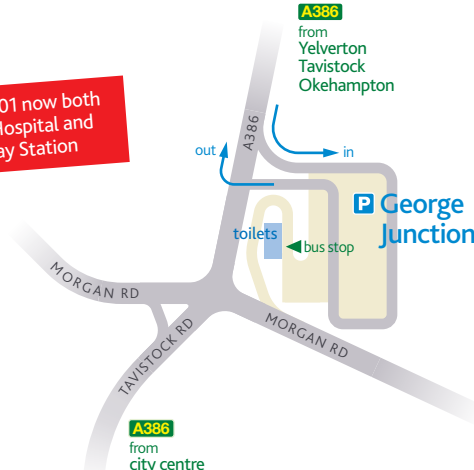

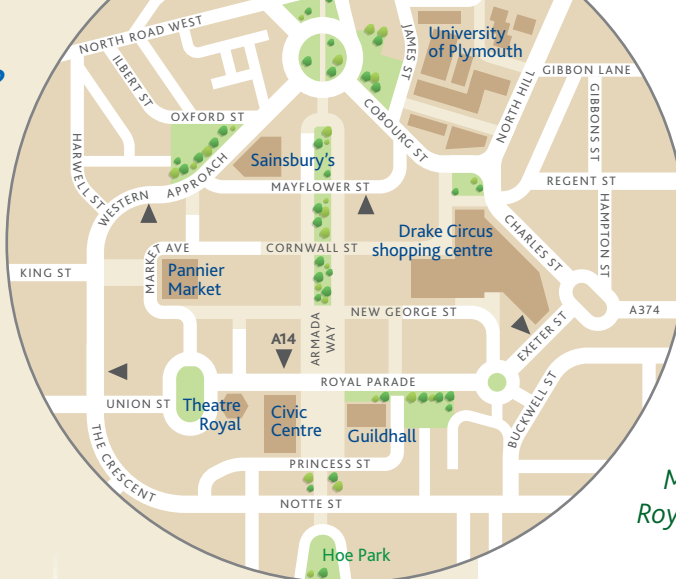
customers for George Junction can also use route 1 after 7pm

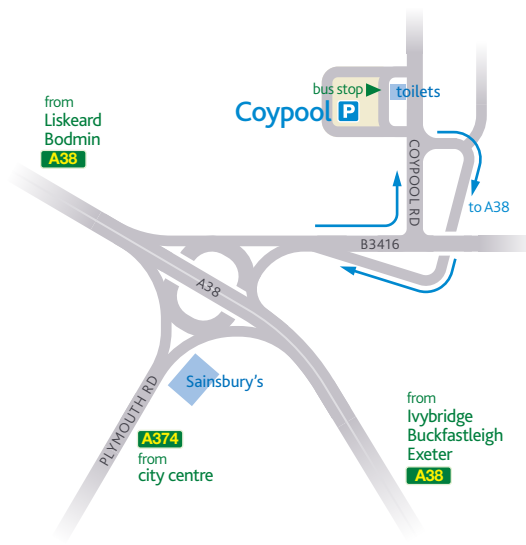
The smart way is to use park & ride. It's safe, secure and really convenient, not to mention easy on your pocket.
